

2022 Returning Health Orders & Guidance

As we have learned together, this health crisis is a fluid situation. Pandemic policies are based on the best available public health data at the time. As new data emerges, the guidelines may be updated without notice to sustain operations and will be shared with families as soon as possible.

Omicron has become a prominent threat to all un-vaccinated individuals, such as our children under 5 and all the immunocompromised. This is due to the fact that it is easily transmittable, although thankfully it has proven to be more mild.

We are Resuming Classes next Monday, January 10th.

The Multi-Cultural Child Development Center is requiring that every staff member is tested, and they must display a negative test result before returning to work. For your information, we are all fully vaccinated.

Before your child returns, please take the following into consideration in order to protect them and the entire Multi-Cultural Family:

- If your child has traveled, he/she must be tested, and may only return with a negative test and after quarantining for 7 days.
- If your child/family have been part of a large gathering (more than 20 people, with possibility of some been un-vaccinated), your child may only return to school with a negative test taken within 48 hours.
- If your child has any symptoms, such as: cough, fatigue, fever, chills, or sneezes, he/she must stay home, and may only return to school with a negative test and Free of symptoms

- If the child has a fever, he/she may not return to school until they are fever-free for 48 hours without the help of medication.
 - If the child or a family member in the household displays ANY signs of COVID-19, they should not enter the facility, and must inform the school. They will be required to quarantine before being able to return. We will provide guidance on how to approach the situation.
 - If staff or children show signs while they are here at school, they will be sent home, and they/you will receive instructions according to the situation.
 - *Please, continue to mask up, wash hands thoroughly for 20 seconds, use hand-sanitizer when hand-washing is not available, avoid touching your eyes, and avoid gathering with a large number of people and in enclosed environments with poor ventilation.*
- * I am attaching local Health Guidance and Testing/Vaccine facilities.
- * If your Child is already 5, it is Highly recommend to be vaccinated if you have not done it yet.
