

Sick Child Updated Policy - 3-07-2022

KEEP YOUR CHILD AT HOME FOR 10 DAYS IF:

He/She has any Cold/flu like symptoms, is sick with any other contagious sickness, or has fever higher than 99 F, vomiting, cough, runny nose and/or diarrhea.

As soon as your child shows any of the following symptoms: Cold/flu like symptoms, is sick with any other contagious sickness, or has fever higher than 99 F, vomiting, cough, heavy runny nose and/or diarrhea, you must have your child take a Rapid Covid 19 test (antigen) and report the results to us immediately.

Your child can only return to school if:

- The result of the Rapid Covid 19 test (Antigen) is NEGATIVE and
- His/her last fever (of 99 or higher) was in the last 48 hours without medication
- Has Not vomited in the last 48 hours without medication
- Had not had diarrhea in the last 48 hours without medication
- Has no more of the other sicknesses or discomfort.

Your child can also return to school with:

- A doctor's note that your child is healthy, is Covid 19 free,
- or his/her runny nose or cough is due to allergies

Or

- A recent Negative Covid 19 antigen or PCR test.

Child is Positive with Covid 19

- Your child must quarantine for 10 days even if he/she is feeling well
- Your child can return to school after quarantining for 10 days, has a Negative Rapid Test (Antigen) AND if he/she is Free of symptoms.

Child has been exposed to anyone with a Positive Covid 19

- Your child does not need to quarantine at home
- Make sure the positive case isolates from the rest.
- Watch your child for any symptoms.
- Test your child with a Rapid Covid 19 test (antigen) on the 5th day after exposure; if the test is "positive", follow the guidance above for a Child is Positive with Covid 19.

Child has cough or runny nose due to allergies

- If your child has a runny nose or cough, we will need a doctor's note that your child is healthy, is Covid 19 free, or his/her runny nose or cough is due to allergies
